- Sound System for main gym ~\$4,000 -In spite of baffles it is still loud. No motion was made at this time. More information will follow.
- Banners for FCA have been sponsored by the Wissler and Associate Family Orthodontics. 4, 4'x6' full-color banners have been created, 2 in landscape and 2 in portrait. These will be portable and can be taken to the 4<sup>th</sup> of July or the fall F.R.O.G. 5K. Anytime FCA needs additional signage, check with the boosters for appropriation.

- Pole Barn: Todd reported that the pole barn needed for additional athletic activity would realistically cost about \$35,000 just for a 'bare bones' structure. It is a priority and would benefit ALL sports for nearly ALL ages and allow FCA to introduce sports at a younger grade level helping us compete better and enroll higher thus offering more stability and ensuring better financial health
